We are updating our Privacy Policy as the rules about Data Protection are changing. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is coming into force on the 25th May 2018. This will affect the way we can keep in touch with you and provide individuals with enhanced rights over their data, replacing the Data Protection Act 1988 in the UK. The GDPR will protect the processing of personal data as a fundamental right for individuals.

We hold your details on our secure Garage Data software programme for both our benefit and our customers. This is done so that we can keep a track of works that have been undertaken, also for Warranty purposes and so we are able to send you reminders for MOT's and Servicing.
